Why should you help?

All medicines have both benefits and side effects. Understanding the balance between the benefits and the side effects is important to everyone involved in developing, licensing and using medicines. It is particularly important for patients and prescribers to help them choose the most appropriate medicine.

Benefits and risks can be communicated in many ways, either as written text or graphically (several graphical methods can be used). However, there is limited information on which method is best to help patients in making treatment decisions.

How can you help?

Who are we?

The survey is part of a scientific study called VISUALizE (**Vis**ualizing **U**ncertainty **A**mong **L**aypersons and **E**xperts). The study is being carried out through the PROTECT project*, a public-private partnership supported by the Innovative Medicines Initiative (IMI), that aims to strengthen the monitoring of the benefit-risk balance of medicines in Europe.

The research group leading the VISUALizE study includes several members of the PROTECT consortium, namely: the European Medicines Agency, University of Groningen, University of Utrecht, the Danish Medicines Agency, Laser and the pharmaceutical companies Sanofi and Amgen.
